


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BIO

Casey is an Associate Professor at Texas A&M University-Commerce, teaching in the Visual Communication Program at the Universities Center at Dallas campus. In addition, he teaches undergraduate Typography, Design 1, and Letterpress printing. He also teaches in the MFA Graduate Program, including Pedagogy and Design Education, Design Teaching Environment, and Thesis Exhibition, and has served as Major Professor on numerous thesis committees.

Casey has worked as a professional designer for 30 years, acting as a creative director, art director, and owner. He owns and operates a letterpress design and print shop, "Inky Lips Letterpress," producing custom invitations and poster work for various local, national, and international clients and teaching educational workshops. His work has been recognized in national and international publications and gallery exhibitions — Casey designs and prints on two Vandercook proof presses. The shop has hundreds of metal fonts and 50 wood fonts that reside in ten type cabinets. He continues to hold workshops for local and regional attendees. Casey has also begun making letterpress wood fonts with a CNC router, elevating the letterpress craft on a national venue.

Casey's letterpress poster work has been awarded in exhibitions and national publications. In 2021 In 2019, he was asked to design and print the 20th Anniversary poster for Hamilton Wood Type and Printing Museum for Wayzgoose, an international conference. Also was invited along with 30 other letterpress printers to design and print HAM at 20, which is Hamilton Wood Type and Printing Museum's 20 years of the Wayzgoose conference.

In 2016-2019, poster work was included in three exhibitions: UFO's over Lubbock in Lubbock, TX, Print Austin in Austin, TX, and It Came From The Bayou in Houston, TX.

Letterpress work was accepted in a juried exhibition in New Jersey at the Drawing Room for the Animal Activist Posters. Invited to exhibit work at the Ink on Paper: A Letterpress Showcase to Exhibition in Orange County, CA, at the Great Park Gallery. 2018 Art of the Poster, two works accepted in the 5th Louisiana Biennial, a National juried Exhibition, 2017 London International Creative Competition, awarded Shortlist, a juried competition, Print Regional Design Annual 2016, and Expression Tipogràfica-Spain.

In May of 2016, Casey was invited to lecture on "Brainstorming and Ideation" at The Tianjin University of Technology in Tianjin, China, with students in China and TAMUC design students. Casey also served as a study abroad faculty co-director with faculty director Professor Virgil Scott, who led ten students to TUT in China for a May-mini study abroad trip that was hugely successful and life-changing.

Ink Workshop, 2017

This morning and afternoon workshop introduced students to the hands-on processes of letterpress and silkscreen printing, two art forms staging a major revival in the field of design. Each participant produced a multi-colored letterpress poster and a silk screened print series. In the letterpress portion of the workshop, students will learn to lock up a form with an image by utilizing vintage metal and wood type. In the screen printing session, teachers will explore image and color layering through a "mash-up" style of silk screen printing. Outcomes will include screen preparation, emulsion coating, image burning, printing, and wash-out techniques.

With over thirty years as a practicing graphic designer and twenty years of letterpress printing have directed my teaching by bringing in professional practice experience into the classroom. My passion for research is self-evident in teaching Master of Fine Arts graduates in the VisCom Program. I continue to produce letterpress invitations, business cards, posters for clients and self promotion. In the summer of 2012 with the purchase of a CNC Router with research funds, I have been able to produce over 30 fonts of type from a historical aspect and designing fonts by manipulating existing digital type.
